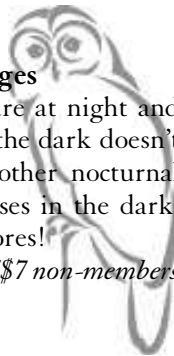
### Family Programs at the Sanctuary

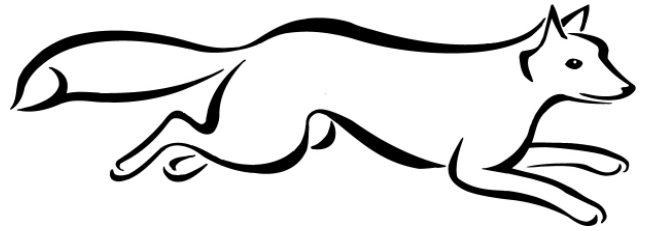
